

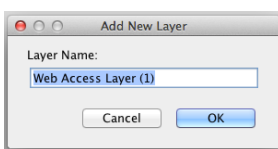
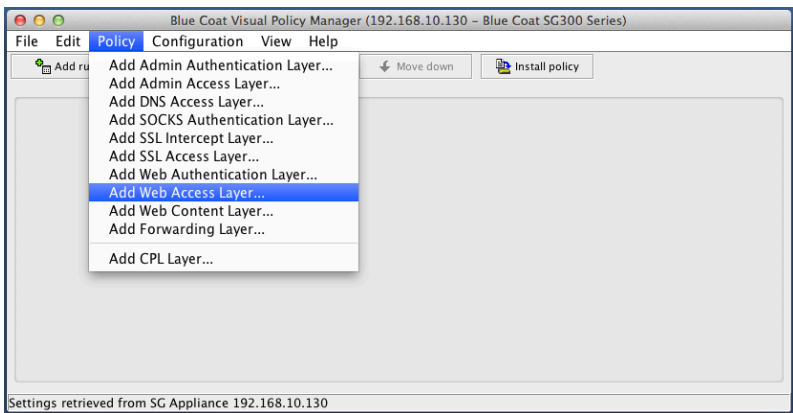
Creating "Category Pairings"

Steps to creating "Category Pairings" to combine multiple BCWF categories in to one policy rule. This is done by creating a "Combined Destination Object" and adding two or more "Request URL Category" objects to it.

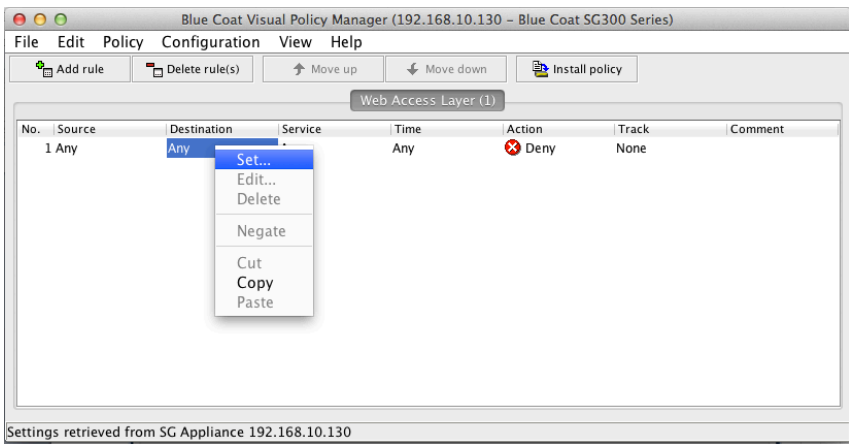
Example: Combining the category of "Social Networking" and "Business" to infer "Professional Networking" category.

Steps required in the VPM

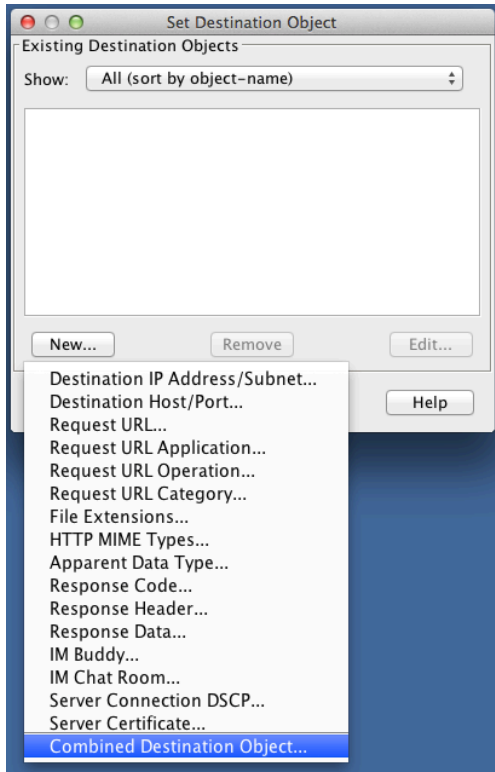
- Add Web Access Layer



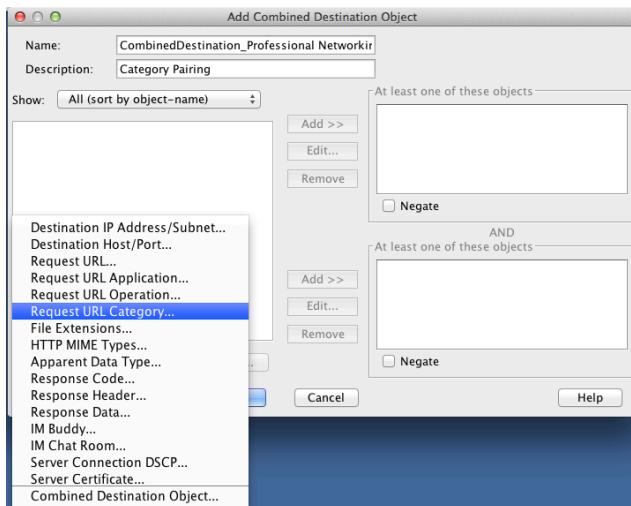
- Set Destination -> Right click "Destination" -> Set -> New



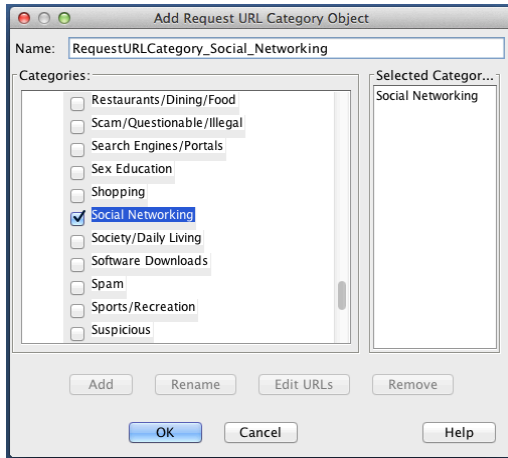
- Select "Combine Destination Object"



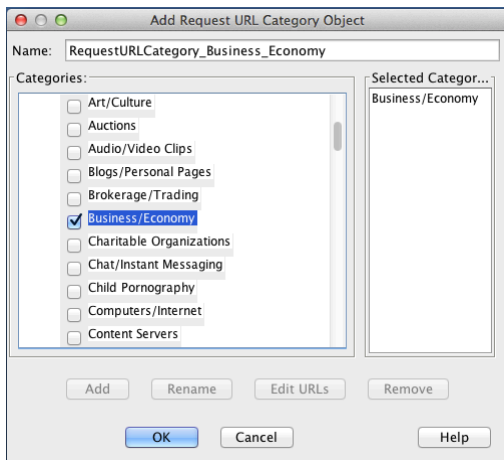
Need to create two Destination Objects used in the Combined object. One for each Category to be matched.

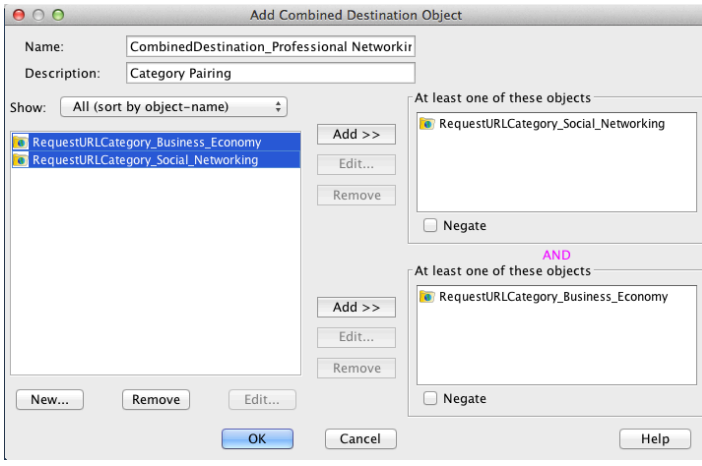

- OK

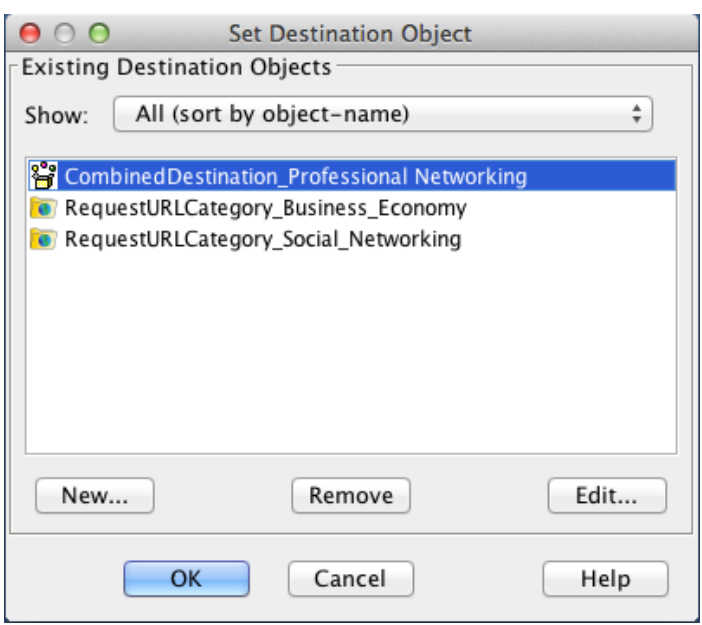


You should have the two created Destination Objects defined listed.

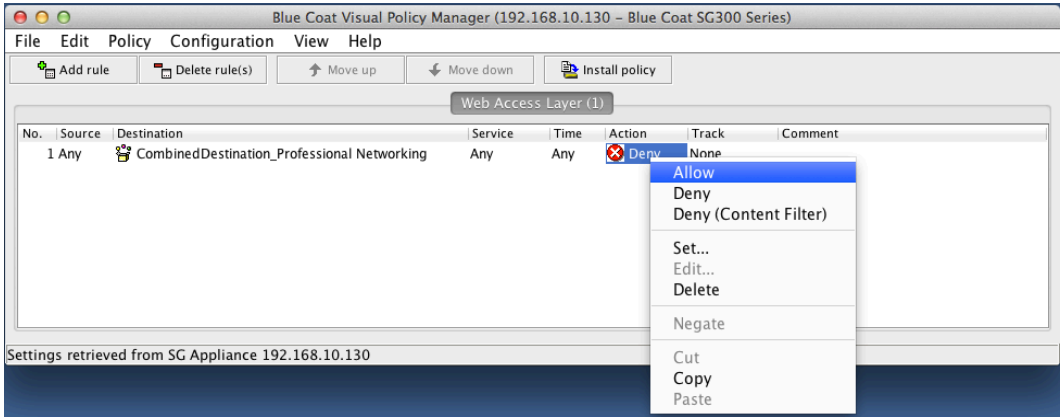
